Sugar & Spice Cookies Georgia Gamm

2 ½ c. flour	1 tsp salt
1 ½ tsp. cinnamon	½ tsp nutmeg
¾ c. shortening	½ c. sugar
1 c. brown sugar	2 eggs
¼ c. milk	3 c. oatmeal
1 c. coconut	

Sift together dry ingredients in a large bowl. Add shortening, sugars, eggs and milk. Mix until smooth. Stir in oatmeal and coconut. You can use raisins instead of coconut. Form into balls and roll in sugar. Bake at 350 for 10 minutes.
