All others will get a card after they take the insurance and will be eligible for club activities. For the period of now till April 15 we only had to have 20 members listed. The next year begins April 15 but we must have **\$8. per person by March 15**. (Insurance is going down for next year). If you have paid your

dues, you will need to pay the difference. **If you have not paid dues please send \$18. to Mike Holder by March 15.** We will become a branch club of the EDGETA for insurance purposes only. If you have any questions, call Jim, Mike or Alois.
