Mike Holder reported that we had \$899.99 in the bank with loans of \$1200.00 from members that helped out with the restroom costs. He also reported that through the MRVSEA organization, we currently get \$14,000.00 of building insurance for \$100.00 which figures out to \$6.75/\$1,000.00. The club voted to raise our coverage to \$20,000.00 with the improvements that have been made. January is when club dues are due.
