A reminder about our club tour to Pella, IA March 26-28. The schedule is:

Thurs. 26th: 1:00 **Williamsburg, IA** to tour the Kinze Manufacturing Plant. You will want to check the map as you will want to go to Williamsburg first, not Pella. This will be followed by tours of two collectors, one M & M and the other John Deere tractors. Dinner on your own. Stores in Pella's downtown area are open on Thursday night to allow for shopping. Pella was settled by Dutch immigrants and their traditions are kept alive in Pella.

Directions to Kinze: Take exit 216 off of I-80. No eating facilities at this exit. If you want to eat before the tour, there are places to eat at exit 220, 4 miles from exit 216.

Fri. 27th: 9:00 am A corn furnace factory (about 1 hr) followed by a tour of the Historic Village which will include the tour of a Windmill and museum. (\$7 per person) About 2 hrs. Lunch on your own.
